Money has been allocated to provide:

- Additional teaching staff for Y2, Y5 and Y6.
- Free Breakfast Club
- Free after school clubs
- Free specialist music tuition
- Free educational visits
- Free residential visits
- Leading Early Years practitioner to run Forest Schools Programme in Reception
- E learning subscriptions-Accelerated Reading Programme and Mathletics
- ipads
- New reading scheme books
- Speech and language support from a trained therapist
- Support from Educational Psychiatrist
- Drawing and Talking Therapy- emotional support
- Targeted Intervention Programmes- including before school and during school hours
- Provide small booster groups for Y6 children, including the more able.
- Provision of revision materials for all Y6 children.
- Provision of before school catch-up sessions for children in phonics and reading.
- Provision of the Talk Boost programme to develop listening skills, vocabulary and sentence production.
- Provision of enrichment activities- visiting theatre groups and authors
