Monday 9 th October	Compassion	Love		Article 2 (non-discrimination) The Convention applies to every child without discrimination, whatever	

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				their ethnicity, gender, religion, language, abilities or any other status, whatever they think or say, whatever their family background.	
Monday 17 th October	Community	Service		Article 15 (freedom of association) Every child has the right to meet with other children and to join groups and organisations, as long as this does not stop other people from enjoying their rights.

Monday 30 th October	Dignity	Trust	Tolerance	Article 8 (protection and preservation of identity) Every child has the right to an identity. Governments must respect and protect that right, and prevent the child's name, nationality or family relationships from being changed unlawfully.	
Monday 6 th November	Remembrance	Thankfulness		Article 38 (war and armed conflicts) Governments must not allow children under the age of 15 to take part in war or join the armed forces. Governments must do everything they can to protect and care for	

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				children affected by war and armed conflicts.	
Monday 13 th November	Peace	Peace	Democracy	Article 13 (freedom of expression) Every child must be free to express their thoughts and opinions and to access all kinds of information, as long as it is within the law.	
Monday 20 th November	Reconciliation	Peace	Democracy	Article 38 (war and armed conflicts) Governments must not allow children under the age of 15 to take part in war or join the armed forces. Governments must do everything they can to protect and care for children affected by war and armed conflicts.	
Monday 27 th November	Wisdom	Wisdom	Individual liberty	Article 28 (right to education) Every child has the right to an education. Primary education must be free and different forms of secondary education must be available to every child. Discipline in schools must respect children's dignity and their rights. Richer countries must help poorer countries achieve this.	
Monday 4 th December	Advent	Thankfulness		Article 30 (children from minority or indigenous groups) Every child has the	

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				right to learn and use the language, customs and religion of their family, whether or not these are shared by the majority of the people in the country where they live.	
Monday 11 th December	Incarnation	Friendship		Article 14 (freedom of thought, belief and religion) Every child has the right to think and believe what they choose and also to practise their religion, as long as they are not stopping other people from enjoying their rights. Governments must respect the rights and responsibilities of parents to guide their child as they grow up.
