Colour	Season Mood	When used	
White	Joy and Rejoice	Christmas, Easter, Epiphany, Ascension, All Saints	
Purple	Thinking deeply and waiting	Advent Lent	
Green	A time to grow	Ordinary days (not celebrations)	
Red	Sad times and certain Joyful times	Ordinary days (not celebrations
