Themes are linked with the Christian calendar and are depicted by colours; each season has a colour and change with the pattern of Worship as shown below

Colour	Season Mood	When used
White	Joy and Rejoice	Christmas, Easter, Epiphany, Ascension, All Saints
Purple	Thinking deeply and waiting	Advent Lent
Green	A time to grow	Ordinary days (not celebrations)
Red	Sad times and certain Joyful times	Ordinary days (not celebrations)

Some schools use these colours to support expression of Anglican distinctiveness and tradition. The liturgical seasons can be depicted with coloured material draped on a focus table or ribbon draped around a cross. Educating for Hope and Aspiration

In the drama of ongoing life, how we learn to approach the future is crucial. Good schools open up horizons of **hope** and **aspiration**, and guide pupils into ways of fulfilling them. They also cope wisely with things and people going wrong. Bad experiences and behaviour, wrongdoing and evil need not have the last word. There are resources for **dignity** and **respect**; **repentance**, **forgiveness**, **truth** and **reconciliation** are possible; and **meaning**, **trust**, **generosity**, **compassion** and hope are more fundamental than meaninglessness, suspicion, selfishness, hardheartedness and despair.

 'normal' by our own measure. The challenge is how we treat those who seem alien, abnormal, disturbingly or
 dangerously different.
