



Free Childcare places

- We are a Governor-led nursery delivering the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) curriculum. We offer 15 hours of free early years education for three and four year olds. A further 15 hours is also available called the extended entitlement (30 hours).
- 15 hours** free childcare is available for all children the term after their third birthday, until they start school.

Child's third birthday	Your child's place will begin
September - December	January
January - March	April
April - August	September

- 30 hours – If you work, you may be able to claim 30 hours free childcare. For eligibility please visit: <https://www.childcarechoices.gov.uk/>
- If you are entitled to **30 hours** free childcare we need your code as soon as possible for funding to start.
- You **must** reconfirm that you are eligible to receive 30 hours free childcare every three months. A letter will be sent to you by HMRC by text or email.

Additional Charges

- There is currently no Breakfast Club provision for Nursery children.
- Extra 3 hour sessions can be added on to your 15 hours at a charge of **£15.00** for childcare (8.45-11.45 or 12.30-3.30)

15 hour children who stay for packed lunch (parents must provide packed lunch)	£4.50
30 hour children who stay for packed lunch (lunchtime is covered by 30 hours free childcare but packed lunch must be provided by a parent)	£0.00
If you would like to purchase a hot meal from the school kitchen there is a daily charge.	£2.64
Extra sessions 8.45-11.45 or 12.30-3.30	£15.00
For 30 hour children 2:45 – 3.30pm childcare	£4.50

- If your child has turned 3 and is waiting for a nursery place (the term after their third birthday) we can accept payment for sessions. This will depend upon numbers and will only be possible if we have nursery spaces available.
