### **Mobile phones**

Reminder that children who bring mobile phones to school, should hand them to the Office, switched off. They can be collected from the Office at the end of the day.

### **Leaving children at gate**

Polite reminder that children should be encouraged to walk onto the yard each morning on their own. The main gate and the yard are supervised by members of staff.

### **After School Clubs**

Could we please remind Parents that all after school clubs finish at 4.30pm and we would be grateful if children could be collected promptly.

### **School start time**

Polite reminder that school starts at 9.00am. The gate will be opened at 8.45am for children to go on the yard and they will be supervised by staff until 9.00am. Please note that the Caretaker will lock the gate at 9.05am, to ensure the safety of all our children. Children arriving after 9am must enter via the Office and will be recorded as late on the register.

### **Earrings**

Could we please remind you that earrings should be removed for PE lessons and where they can't be removed, they should be taped.

### **Reading books**

We have a number of reading books being returned from home damaged or not being returned at all. Could we please ask that care is taken with any books taken home.

### **Speaking with staff**

Could we please ask that Parents do not enter classrooms on a morning. If you need to speak with a member of staff, please wait at classroom entrance or speak with the Office.





## **Parking**

Could we please ask you to consider our neighbours when parking your car outside of school. On a number of occasions ,drive ways have been blocked.

## **Breakfast Club**

Breakfast Club is now available for all children across school, including Nursery children. Entry is from 8.00am, with last entry at 8.30am. Children are to be supervised by an adult until handed over to a staff member and should enter via the Main Entrance. Breakfast Club is charged at £2.50 per day and booking is not required. For children in receipt of pupil premium funding, Breakfast Club is free of charge.

*Could we please remind Parents that children will not be supervised until 8am when Breakfast Club opens.*

## **Medical appointments**

We have a large number of children leaving school early each day for medical appointments.
