A big thank you to Joanne for stepping in to take the team.
































































On Wednesday Alison came to visit Reception class.

#### Medication in school

Polite reminder that children should not have medication in their bags. All medication must be handed to the Office and the relevant form completed.

#### New Menu Choices

The new winter menu is now available to select via Arbor. The menu will be in operation from Monday 6 November. Please ensure that you have selected your child's menu choices before then. As always if you need to amend the choice, you can do so up to 9am on the day the lunch is taken. Children wishing to move to or from school lunches, please contact the Office giving at least 2 weeks notices.

#### **Breakfast Club**

Could we please remind everyone attending breakfast club that the last entry is 8.30am.

#### Names on clothing

We regularly have items of clothing which are lost around school. To help us identify who the clothing belongs to and return items to their rightful owners, could we please ask that all items of clothing are labelled with either your child's name or initials.

#### Smart watches

A number of our children were bought Smart watches for Christmas. Whilst these are wonderful gifts, they can only be worn in school if they do not have a camera and/or games facilities.

#### **Mobile phones**

Reminder that children who bring mobile phones to school, should hand them to the Office, switched off. They can be collected from the Office at the end of the day.

#### Leaving children at gate

Polite reminder that children should be encouraged to walk onto the yard each morning on their own. The main gate and the yard are supervised by members of staff.

Polite reminder that children who have vomited or have had diarrhoea should remain off school for 48 hours from the last episode. This is to ensure your child is fully fit before returning to school and also to help stop the spread of illness to children and staff. Thank you

Could we please ask you to consider our neighbours when parking your car outside of school. On a number of occasions, drive ways have been blocked.

#### **Absence reporting**

Polite reminder that all absences and medical appointments should be reported to the Office by telephone on 01388 603359 each day.

#### **Medical appointments**

We have a large number of children leaving school early each day for medical appointments. Whilst we understand the difficulties in booking appointments, could we please ask that wherever possible appointments are made outside of school hours to limit disruption to your child's education. We will also be asking for evidence of medical appointments. This can be an appointment card, text etc.

#### **Holiday requests**

Polite reminder that all holiday requests must be made in advance, with forms available from the Office. Please be aware that only in exceptional circumstances will your request will be approved.

#### **Earrings**

Could we please remind you that earrings should be removed for PE lessons and where they cant be removed, they should be taped.

#### **Reading books**

We have a number of reading books being returned from home damaged or not being returned at all. Could we please ask that care is taken with any books taken home. Any lost or damaged books will be charged at £2.00 per book, to your child's Arbor account.
